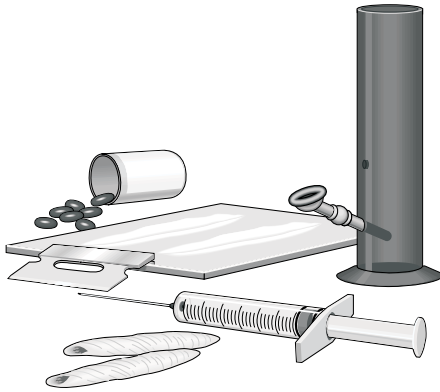

This chapter includes 361 resources for a wide variety of addictions: alcohol, drug, co-dependency, co-occurring, dual-diagnosis, eating disorders, gambling and sexual addictions. The listings include programs offering: detox, residential treatment, residential rehab, outpatient, self-help programs such as AA, NA, referral hotlines and websites offering substance recovery referrals.

Although, the focus of this directory is free and low-cost resources, we attempted to list all the certified substance abuse treatment programs, in Alabama, without regard to their fees. We have also tried to help you identify these state certified programs by including the following statement in the agency listing. "This program is Certified by Alabama Dept of Mental Health Substance Abuse Svcs."

Keep in mind, many of the private agencies may offer a sliding fee scale because they have a state grant to provide discounted services to low income clients. If your funds are limited, be sure to ask the cost of the program and the availability of a sliding scale. We have also listed many nonprofit programs which are completely free or have only a small fee.

In Alabama, substance abuse treatment programs are **Certified by the Alabama Department of Mental Health, Substance Abuse Services Division**. Consult their website at www.mh.alabama.gov to obtain the guidelines for substance abuse programs. The site also maintains current list (updated weekly) of certified substance abuse treatment programs. This is your best source for identifying currently certified treatment programs. We included a line stating the agency is certified, if they appeared on the state list of certified programs in January, 2008. Hopefully, many of the other service providers will also become certified during this next year.

Dentists/Medicaid/Low Cost



This chapter contains 269 resources for dental care. We tried to list all the county and non-profit dental agencies we could find as well as private dentist who will accept Medicaid. Sometimes terms are confusing and we were asked to explain the difference in Medicare and Medicaid. Medicaid may cover dental services for qualifying children up to their 21st birthday, however, not all dentists accepting Medicaid will take all ages. To help you understand the difference between Medicare and Medicaid. We have taken the explanation from the US Dept of Health and Human Services and listed it below.

Medicare is an insurance program. Medical bills are paid from trust funds which those covered have paid into. It serves people over 65 primarily, whatever their income; and serves younger disabled people and dialysis patients. Patients pay part of costs through deductibles for hospital and other costs. Small monthly premiums are required for non-hospital coverage. Medicare is a federal program. It is basically the same everywhere in the United States and is run by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services, an agency of the federal government.

Medicaid is an assistance program. Medical bills are paid from federal, state and local tax funds. It serves low-income people of every age. Patients usually pay no part of costs for covered medical expenses. A small co-payment is sometimes required. Medicaid is a federal-state program. It varies from state to state. It is run by state and local governments within federal guidelines.
